

ACGME Core Curriculum for Geriatric Medicine Fellows: 2007-2008

The ACGME mandates teaching about very specific geriatrics topics to ensure competency in the field of geriatric medicine. This teaching about “ACGME Core Topics” will occur in a variety of venues that consist of both formal didactic presentations and more informal educational sessions that occur in the context of specific rotations. The formal didactic presentations will occur in the context of the Division of Geriatrics Conference (8-9:30 on Friday), the Geriatrics Core Conference series (noon on Monday), or small group didactic sessions. As fellows are required to learn about each of these ACGME Core Topics, all didactic presentations will be available for review on the Division’s shared drive.
